Please keep Mark Nimo and the conference in your daily prayers. Hope to see you in August. May God continue to bless you.

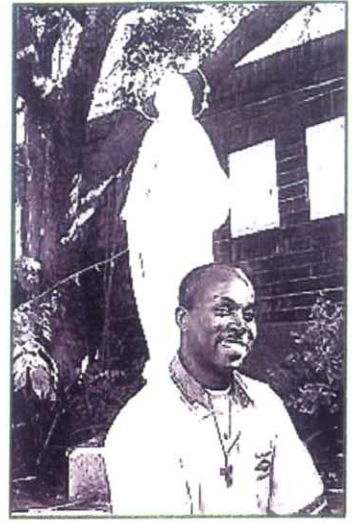

Mark Nimo lives in Chicago, Illinois, with his wife Mercy and their young daughter Michele Marie. He was born in the country of Ghana in West Africa, and Mark is the fifth of seven children. After encountering the Catholic Charismatic Renewal Movement following high school, Mark discovered a new passion for prayer, studying the Bible, and sharing these passions with others. He received ministry training at the International Catholic Program of Evangelization (I.C.P.E.) in Malta, Europe.

In 1991, he became a missionary among people dying with HIV/AIDS in Uganda where he also served on a team that trained Catholic evangelizers. In 1993, he returned to Ghana to head the “*Know and Tell the Gospel*” School of Evangelization. Mark also served for nearly 10 years as servant-leader and representative of English- and Portuguese-speaking Africa on the International Catholic Charismatic Renewal Services (ICCRS) council in Vatican. As a gifted and anointed lay evangelist, worship leader, and youth minister, he has ministered the gospel of Jesus in over 33 countries on several continents. He holds a Masters in Pastoral theology and currently both serves on the Service Team for Catholic Charismatic Renewal and is Director of Religious Education of the Archdiocese of Chicago.
